EIGHT NIGHTS is a new play by Jennifer Maisel and tells the story of Rebecca, a young Holocaust survivor and refugee, who is finally free to start anew in the United States but must confront the past that haunts her.

The play spans eight decades of Rebecca's life, and touches upon not only the story of Holocaust survivors, but also the global refugee experience. It acknowledges the trauma mirrored in the African-American community, with interned Japanese citizens and the current Syrian crisis, gracefully weaving together heart-aching moments with dark yet life-affirming humor.
