EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR REPORT TO CBH BOARD NOVEMBER 11, 2019

• HR Updates:

- Ridge Tolbert, our part-time Communication Coordinator, has resigned.
- Sari Stricke does our social media, also part-time, from home in LA, and after consulting with Ridge and interviewing her by phone, she agreed to assume both duties on a trial basis, which will eventually result in a half-time position if all goes well.
 - She plans to move with her family to Davis as soon after January as possible.
 - She is being trained by Ridge over the next couple of weeks.
- Doug Walter, our Office Coordinator, is still out on sick leave and we need to bring in some stable help so Wendy and I can get back to our jobs.
 - Lora Barrett is already employed as a Hebrew School teacher and has done admin work for Ardyth in the recent past (Ardyth is on board with her and agrees she's a good candidate)
 - She is retaining her job as a Hebrew School teacher and will be able to work 3-4 days per week in the morning, until Doug is able to return.
 - Doug has started to train her by phone o0n how to fulfill the duties of the position, and we are taking this opportunity to streamline and document office procedures.

• Security Questions:

- As part of my Organizational Assessment of Congregation Bet Haverim, I looked at several issues concerning security:
 - 1. There is a potential problem with completing the Security Grant on time that will be addressed later in this meeting.
 - 2. Fire alarms are only on office and preschool buildings, and do not ring to anyone in CBH or to Davis FD.
 - 3. No fire alarms in social hall or sanctuary
 - 4. No direct communication between office and Sunshine Room in case of emergency (Sunshine Room is on the office phone system). Options for correcting this have started.
 - 5. Discussed fire alarms with Davis FD and they gave only very broad guidance, suggesting we consult a qualified commercial vendor. These conversations started this week and bids will be submitted that bring CBH up to current code, most likely by the next board meeting.
