COVID19 Protocol & Guidelines

It is a high priority to provide opportunities for our CBH teens to return to campus for social gatherings. On behalf of the Education & Youth Programs, Ardyth would like to support allowing the two remaining DRTY Board Meetings (scheduled for Monday, May 3rd and Monday, June 1st), the final DRTY event (scheduled for Saturday, June 5th) and a general Teen Community event (to be scheduled for Sunday, May 2nd) to be on campus.

Expected attendance for the DRTY Board Meetings will be ten (10) teens; for the Teen Event potentially twenty-five (25) teens; for the DRTY Event potentially thirty (30) teens.

Staffing for these events will include the following:

DRTY Board Meetings: staffed by Alexander Watson, Teen Engagement Coordinator

DRTY Event: staffed by Alexander Watson, Ardyth Sokoler; potentially also Tim Brown (Keshet Teacher)

Teen Community Event: staffed by Ardyth Sokoler, Rabbi Greg Wolfe, Alexander Watson, Tim Brown

It is noted that the CBH Task Force on COVID19 (TFoC) is very concerned about the possible risk that our teens may encounter during such an event. In order to support full transparency and education of this risk, all teen participants and their parents will be required to sign an Informed Consent Form provided by CBH.

a. Should Yolo County exhibit an increase in COVID19 infections, these events may be cancelled.

b. All CBH staff and teens will be required to properly wear masks throughout the event. In the event that food is served, all food items will be individually plated (pizza) or packaged (water bottles, fruit). Food will only be available for a brief, specified time within the program. Staff will remind and enforce prompt and proper wearing of masks as soon as the designated time for food is concluded.

c. Social distancing will be maintained throughout each of these events. We will be using the Redwood Grove with appropriate spacing designated and marked before each event begins. If any teen is not following appropriate social distancing, they will not be able to participate and will be asked to leave the event immediately.

d. All teen participants will provide a negative COVID test within 3 days of the event to Ardyth.

e. All CBH staff and teen volunteers will be required to complete a COVID19 screening and have their temperature taken upon arrival.

f. We can utilize one of the bathrooms with outside access, either the Social Hall bathroom or the bathroom connected to the North Classroom (the side facing the Redwood Grove). Disinfecting wipes will be available and teens will be encouraged to disinfect the bathroom before usage.
